Davis Campbell retired as Executive Director of the California School Boards Association in 2001 after fourteen years in that role and a distinguished career in public education. Prior to his retirement Davis served as Executive Director of the California Institute for School Improvement and managing partner with SRA Associates. Previously, he served as Deputy State Superintendent of Public Instruction—responsible for all education programs in the State of California. He maintains an active consulting practice in effective governance at national and international level.

Davis has served on a number of boards in public education including EdSource (President, 2007- 2009), the Center for the Future of Teaching and Learning (founding Chairman), the California Institute for School Improvement, and was a founding board member for the California Cities, Counties, Schools Partnership. Davis has also served as a Commissioner for the Yolo County Aging and Adult Services Commission, the Yolo County Mental Health Commission, the Yolo County Board of Education, the UC Davis Foundation board, and Chair of the Board of Advisors for the UC Davis School of Education. In 2020 Campbell received the UC Davis Alumnae Association Distinguished Achievement Award.
